Open Season Terms

Firm Intrastate Transportation

Oasis Pipeline, LP (Oasis) is soliciting bids from Shippers interested in acquiring firm forward haul transportation service utilizing Oasis's Transportation Service under the following criteria:

- **Transporter** - Oasis Pipeline, LP
- **Capacity Path** – Waha area receipt points connected to Oasis Pipeline for redelivery to the Oasis Katy Hub. New receipt points will be considered.
- **Open Season Term:** May 15, 2017 through June 23, 2017
- **Available Capacity** –
 - 300,000 MMBtu per day starting August 1, 2017
 - 450,000 MMBtu per day starting September 1, 2019
 - 600,000 MMBtu per day starting September 1, 2020
 - The bid shall be for Firm capacity up to 300,000 per Day for the term of August 1, 2017 until August 31, 2019 (the “Original Quantity”), then effective September 1, 2019 through August 31, 2020 the capacity shall increase by 50% of the Original Quantity, then effective September 1, 2020 through July 31, 2027 the capacity shall again increase by 50% of the Original Quantity
 - Example: 50,000 MMBtu (Original Quantity) shall be effective August 1, 2017 until August 31, 2019 and shall become 75,000 MMBtu effective September 1, 2019 through August 31, 2020 and shall become 100,000 MMBtu effective September 1, 2020 through July 31, 2027
- **Minimum Contract Term** – 10 years from the effective date of August 1, 2017
- **Minimum Demand Fee bid** – \$0.50 Per MMBtu
- **Commodity Fee** - \$0.01 Per MMBtu
- **Retention Volume** – 1.85%
- **Service Type** – Firm Intrastate Transportation
- **Terms and Conditions** subject to Transporter's Intrastate Natural Gas Transportation Service Agreement: <http://opletconnect.energytransfer.com/ipost/OPL/posted-documents/document-list?documentPage=Transportation+Services&documentCat=Intrastate+Service+Agreement>

All bids shall be deemed to be binding on Shippers. Oasis reserves the right to reject any and all bids, including non-conforming as well as conforming bids. Bids that do not meet the criteria set forth above, are incomplete or would require changes to the Service Agreement and/or Oasis' Statement of Operating Conditions will be deemed non-conforming bids. Oasis's discretion to reject or accept a bid shall be exercised on a not unduly discriminatory basis. After the close of this Open Season, Oasis will evaluate all bids. Awards of capacity, if any, will be based on the bidders whose transaction received in this Open Season provides the greatest economic benefit to Transporter, in Transporter's sole judgment.
